BUCKS COUNTY PERFORMING ARTS CENTER (BCPAC) TEAMS UP WITH MCCAFFREY'S FOR CONCERT SERIES OPENER ON OCTOBER 2

In dual celebration of its new name and the resurrected success of its long-standing business partner Jim McCaffrey, the Bucks County Performing Arts Center (BCPAC; formerly the Lower Makefield Society for the Performing Arts) announced it will hold its premier concert of the 2005-6 season on the mezzanine level of McCaffrey's newly rebuilt store in Yardley (Edgewood Shopping Center). This unprecedented performance will also be the fine arts organization's rollout fundraiser for the season and will be the first under the banner of its new name. Hors d'oeuvres, dessert, and wine will be served following the performance.

Scheduled for Sunday afternoon, October 2, 2005 at 3:00 p.m., the concert will feature the renowned Wister Quartet, violinist virtuoso David Kim, concertmaster for the Philadelphia Orchestra, and the artwork of local photographer Robert McCartney. Proceeds from the concert will benefit BCPAC's partnership development and programming outreach into Bucks County schools. The organization has already developed a working model with the local Pennsbury Partnership program, and draws a variety of talent from all art disciplines throughout the country and overseas. Each season's programming is designed to appeal to all age levels and a wide range of personal favorites while providing sought-after educational benefits for principals, teachers, parents, and students.

Tickets are extremely limited in quantity, and are available for \$75. Prepayment and ticket purchases in advance are strongly recommended. Tickets are available through the BCPAC office, McCaffrey's store in Yardley, the Lower Makefield Township Tax Office, and event co-sponsor ProLine Music. Checks and money orders should be made payable to BCPAC.

BCPAC is a registered non-profit organization based in Lower Makefield Township. Its mission is devoted to the creation of community through the arts.
