BUCKS COUNTY PERFORMING ARTS CENTER (BCPAC) PRESENTS A VETERANS DAY CELEBRATION FEATURING SUPERSTAR JAZZ GUITARIST

The Bucks County Performing Arts Center (BCPAC) continues with its *Fall Jazz Series* by bringing to town jazz superstar Jimmy Bruno who will “light it up” with his two accompanying sidemen, Bill Schilling, organ and Mike DeMonte, drums. Jazz lovers from all over the area will not want to miss this opportunity to hear such outstanding world-renowned skill and artistry in a local venue. This concert of exciting jazz performances will take place on Saturday evening, November 7 at 7:30 P.M. in the historic Yardley Community Centre. *There will be a Veterans Day Celebration with an appearance of Maria Sciorillo, Miss Pennsylvania opening the program by singing “God Bless America”. In addition, Danny Quill, our oldest veteran will be our “Guest of Honor”.*

Born July 22, 1953 in Philadelphia, Jimmy Bruno is now a master jazz guitarist and jazz educator. One of the most critically acclaimed jazz guitarists performing today, Bruno came to prominence as a jazz musician in the 1990’s following a successful twenty-year career as a much sought-after commercial and session guitarist. After a whirlwind round-the-world tour as the youngest member of the Buddy Rich Orchestra, he went on to play guitar in orchestras for the likes of Frank Sinatra, Wayne Newton, and Lena Horne. During his years as a Los Angeles session musician with Tommy Tedesco, Jimmy also played in dozens of TV and film scores. But his first love was always jazz, and by the time he was in his mid-thirties he was ready to step out on his own into the spotlight.

In 1992, Bruno landed a multi-CD recording deal with legendary jazz label Concord Records. Since then he has recorded over 13 critically acclaimed CDs, including “Sleight of Hand,” “Like That,” and “Polarity.” His most recent CD “Maplewood Avenue” (Affiliated Artists Records) was described as having “...a 'classic' feel to it...like a famous album we somehow hadn't discovered yet.” Jimmy performs constantly as leader of the Jimmy Bruno Trio in jazz venues and jazz festivals around the world, and is often described as one of the greatest jazz guitarists of all time. In May of 2007, he opened the Jimmy Bruno Guitar Institute (JBGI). With his unique insight into jazz and jazz guitar, Jimmy is constantly in demand to teach master classes.

Tickets are available for \$15, \$12 (seniors) & \$8 (students). Subscription packages are also being offered this year at even further reduced prices.
